It's difficult to see real needs and not want to rush the process to appease our own desire for restoration." How did Silas and others at The Bridge strive to find that balance? Did Molly learn to find this balance over the course of the story?

8	Silas says, "Love lives in the hard places with us because that's what sets it apart. That's what makes it love." How do you see this in Silas's relationship with Molly? In Molly's relationship with her brother, or Val, or the young women at The Bridge?
9	Molly and Silas are an opposites-attract kind of couple. What do you think makes them good for each other?
10	Did Ethan's vindictive actions at the end of the book surprise you, or did you expect that Molly wasn't through with him and his manipulation?
