



Discussion Guide for *Night Fall*

1. Alex Donovan was raised by a mentally ill aunt. Because of her aunt's struggles, Alex had to be the adult in the relationship. When she turns eighteen, she leaves home and never looks back. Although she sends her aunt money from time to time, she has no personal contact with her. Can you relate to how Alex feels about her past? Do you think she did the right thing by staying away from what she considered to be a toxic environment?
2. Logan feels an attraction to Alex, but because she is obviously carrying emotional baggage from her past and isn't a Christian, he keeps his feelings to himself. Is Logan handling this correctly? Or should he tell Alex the truth about how he feels about her?
3. Were you impacted spiritually by *Night Fall*? How?
4. Two people have very harsh childhoods. One turns to hurting other people to find justice for his past while the other is determined to join the FBI and bring justice for others. Do you believe we all have a choice in life, or are we not responsible for our reactions when we have been deeply scarred by things that were out of our control?
