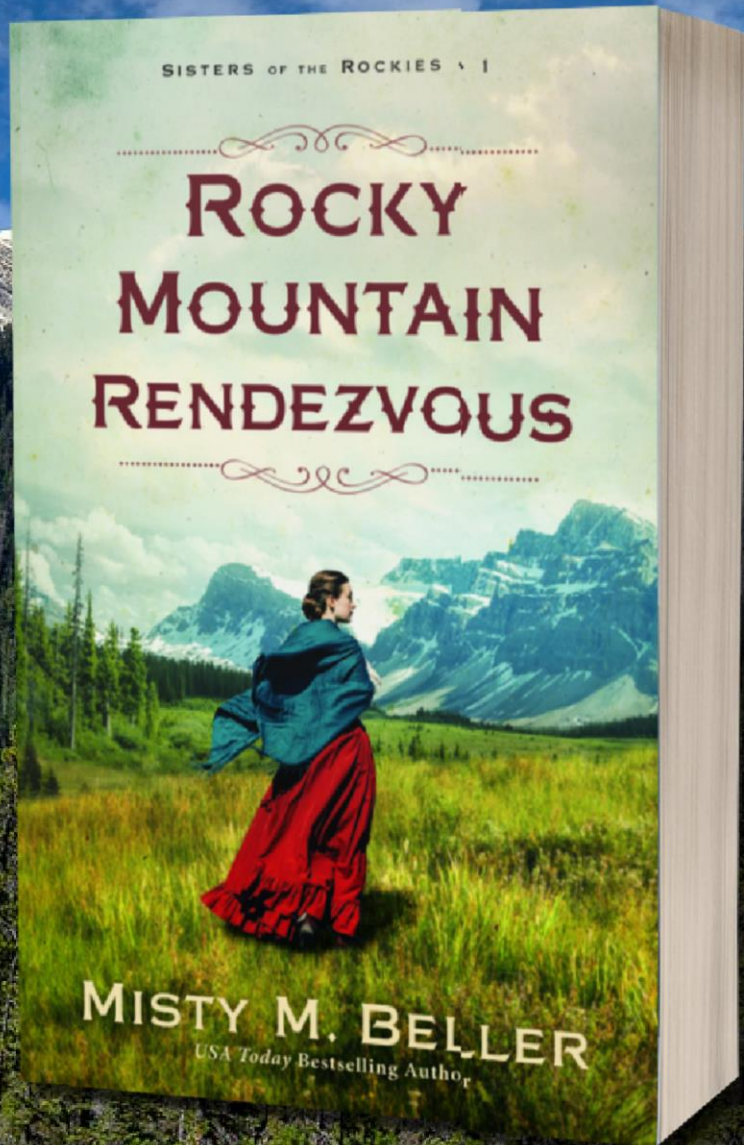

And you, Dear Reader, bring so much joy to my life! I pray for you regularly, especially those wonderful words in Colossians:



Book Club Discussion Questions for *Rocky Mountain Rendezvous*

- 1. How does the setting of the Rocky Mountains during the 1837 trapper rendezvous contribute to the overall atmosphere and challenges faced by the characters in the story?**
 - 2. Discuss the bond between Juniper and her sisters. How does their shared mission to fulfill their father's request impact their relationship, and how do they support and rely on each other throughout their journey?**
 - 3. Riley Turner is initially drawn to Juniper Collins. What are the qualities that make her stand out to him, and how does their relationship develop over the course of the book? Do you think their connection is believable and well-developed?**
